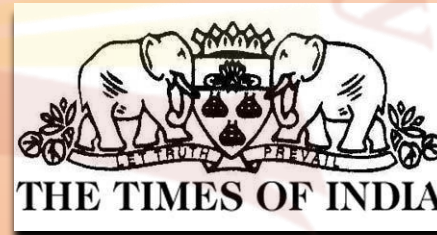

The project 22220 nuclear-powered icebreakers are the most powerful icebreakers, the construction for Sibir began in the year 2015 and the icebreakers floated on 22 December 2017. The icebreaker was handed over to Rosatom state atomic energy corporation for exploitation, Indian expressed its interest in collaborating with Russia during the 21st Indian Russia summit, at present Russia has 6 nuclear-powered icebreakers and also has a nuclear-powered cargo ship named 'Sevmorput'.
