- With 28,264 fresh cases on Sunday, Karnataka is witnessing a slow decline in the spread of the virus and has urged the citizens to be more vigilant about their health and take all the necessary steps to avoid catching the virus, the state's capital Bengaluru reported 11,938 cases and 14 deaths and Mysuru reported 2,322 cases with 10 deaths, the number surely is declining with each passing day and the overall positivity rate has fallen down to 16.38%. The total active number of cases is at around 2,51,000 out of which around 1,115 of them are omicron variant cases, the total number of recoveries in the past 244 hours is around 29,000.

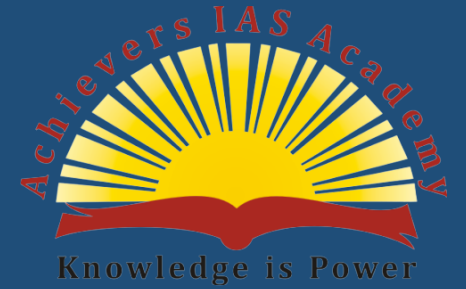
